- Have fun with it; it's truly a once in a lifetime event for the kids at your school!






Fuel for Kids Info


At Your School

- Your school will receive a visit from the FORTINOS Race Team and the actual driver; Dave Connelly.
- Dave and his team will arrive at your school to deliver your students a very unique "Show and Tell".
- The "Show and Tell" will be an informative and educational talk about the various safety elements both in what Dave wears as a driver and what is designed into his actual racecar.
- Dave can handle up to 500 students in one talk, his show and tell typically last 20 minutes.
- At the end Dave often has the school assembled outside for his final "donut" goodbye – which is always a hit with students and staff!

At The Store

Hints for a Successful Store Fundraising Event

- Promote Your Event: Letters home to Mom and Dad, Twitter, Facebook, Voicemails, Posters at School are some of the ways that schools have got the word out.
- PARENT VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: Get your parent council involved to make this work. This is the easiest fundraiser of the year.
- We will be selling Pillers Sausage, Hot Dogs, and the "Snack packages- which will include: a drink, and snacks etc." for \$5.00. All of the food is donated (so every dollar raised goes directly to your school).
- The BBQ will take place at your local FORTIONOS from 4pm to 7pm on the day of your event.
